## Counting Jumps

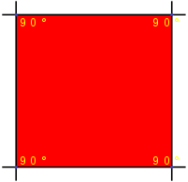
Do 10 jumps in each room of your house. Count each jump to make sure you do 10.

Practise writing the number **10** at home.

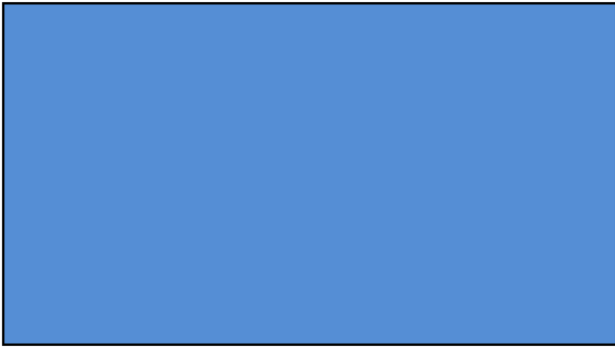


# 2D Shapes
